


Introduction

Calls for Service have decreased this month from the previous month. We are encouraging our officers to increase traffic enforcement in key areas of the city. Our response time remains consistent and within our expectations. Additionally, we have been working on increasing the visibility of our officers in and around schools in our community. We are continuing to work on updating our policies and procedures to align with best practices. We have implemented a new web-based policy management system to assist with this process.

The month of November was particularly busy when it came to filling vacant positions in the department. Our new Captain, Paul Chrane started in November. We also made job offers for two vacant Police Officer positions and two vacant Dispatcher positions. Also during this month, we held our annual firearm qualification. I am happy to report that all of our officers passed the qualification and exceeded standards.

We were also very excited to unveil our new department shoulder patch this month! The majority of this design was done by officers in the department to which I made some very minor modifications. Our team is very proud of this design and the forward moving direction it symbolizes for our department.

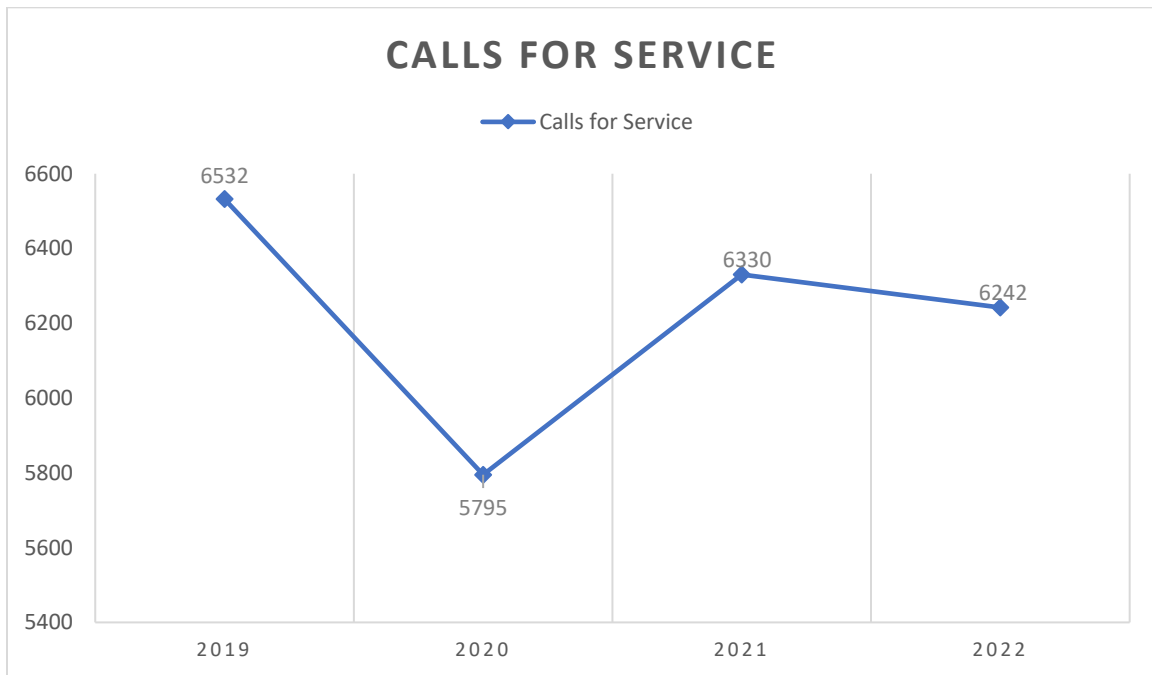

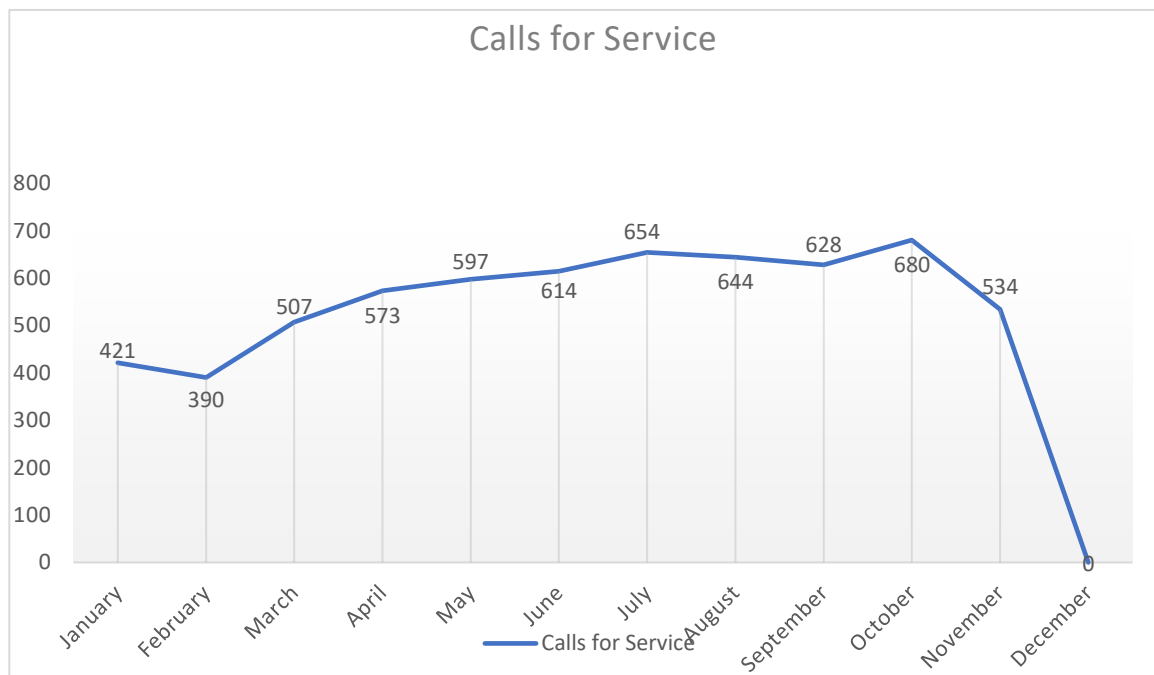

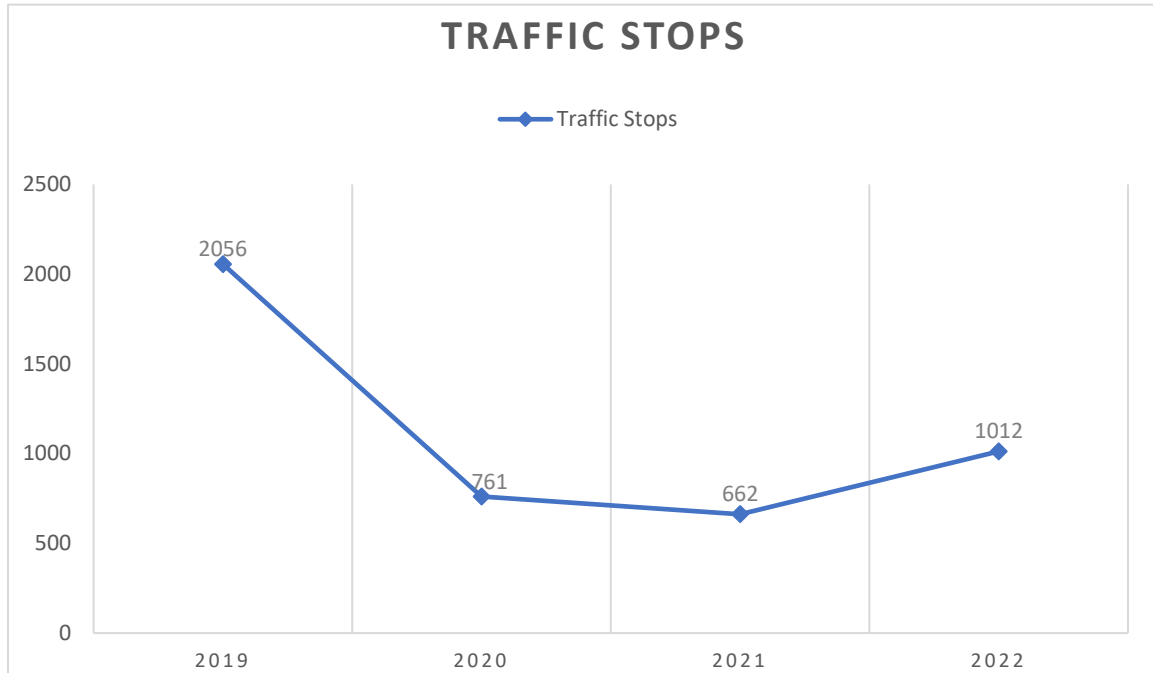
Calls for Service – Historical and Year-to-Date



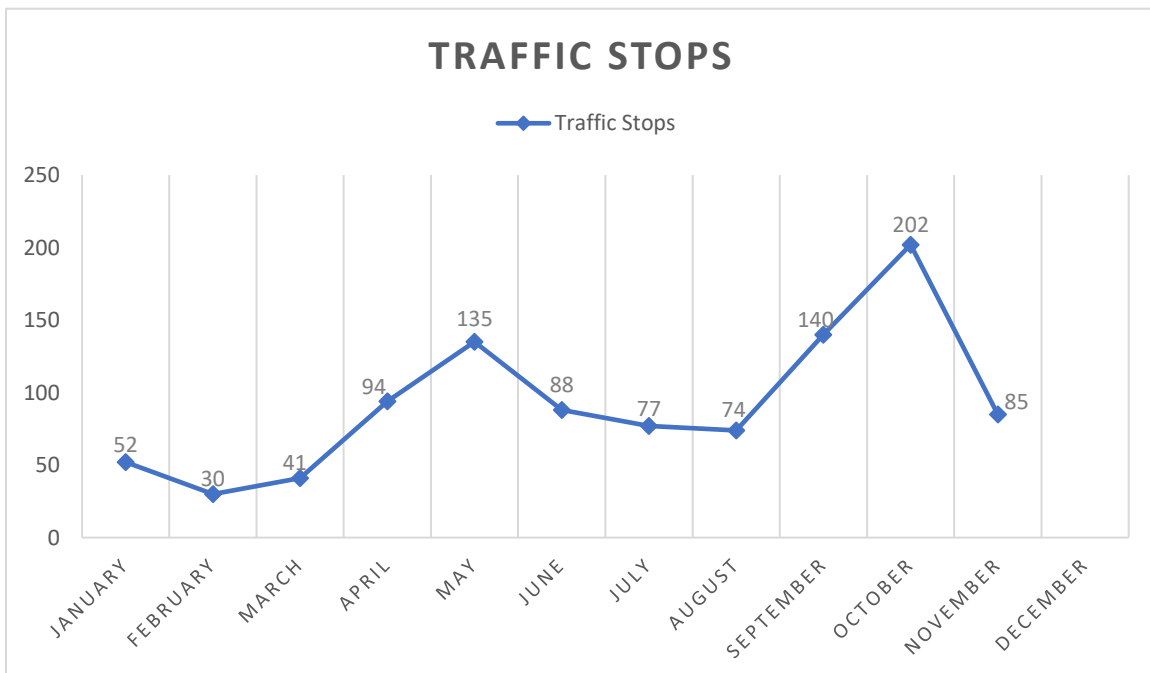
Calls for Service – 2022 by Month
