Introduction

Calls for Service increased slightly this month from the previous month. We are encouraging our officers to increase traffic enforcement in key areas of the city. Our response time remains consistent and within our expectations. Additionally, we have been working on increasing the visibility of our officers in and around schools in our community. We are continuing to work on updating our policies and procedures to align with best practices.

During the month of October, we held our first 'Coffee with the Chief' event on National Coffee with Cops Day. The goal of these events is to have conversations with our citizens in an informal setting. We are planning to make this a monthly event. Our officers also participated in the city-wide Trunk or Treat, handing out goodie bags and candy.

We appreciate the support of our City Manager and City Council in approving the purchase of new body cameras, Taser ® devices, and software for the department. These will greatly enhance our team's ability to provide effective services to our citizens.

Please take note of the Staff section in this report as we have had a lot of movement on filling vacant positions. There is still a lot of work to do on this front, but we are seeing some forward momentum.






Calls for Service – Historical and Year-to-Date
