Meet Your City Workers - Hayley Holt's Passion for Water Conservation

Where does our household water come from? Haley Holt laughs when she recalls thinking this as a child while growing up on Lake Travis. Today she understands water a finite resource, and this knowledge has turned to dedication in her work with the Water Plant Operations team inside the Public Works Department. "I'm passionate about stewardship of our water resources so future generations can enjoy the lake we all love," she said.

Hayley wants to educate our community on conservation practices and recommends simple measures everyone can take to care for our natural resource while also saving money on our utility bills.

Pools, spas, and fountains account for significant water use that can be costly. Stay cool and be smart at the same time, Haley recommends. Cover your pools and spas when not in use to lessen evaporation. Backwash your filter only as necessary. Turn off decorative fountains on windy days and during droughts.

Keeping a beautiful lawn takes care, upkeep, and precious water. Knowing the best time to water your lawn is important not only to keep it green, but to stay in compliance with current watering restrictions in our area. Water your plants deeply during these times and add a high quality mulch to protect your plants against scorching Texas heat, retain moisture, reduce run off, and reduce soil erosion. The best time to water is early morning when it's cooler and still dark out. Check your sprinkler system for common issues such as bubbling or excessive water runoff, broken or sunken heads, or misdirected heads. Consider a "smart" irrigation system.

The City of Lago Vista is currently under Stage One water restrictions. Watering restrictions are designed to conserve water in order to provide a reserve in times of drought or emergency conditions. During Stage One water restrictions, residents may irrigate outdoors using an in-ground irrigation system or hose-end sprinkler no more than twice a week and only during scheduled days and times as indicated below:

The City Council serves as the legislative and governing body of the City of Lago Vista. City Council provides and administers a number of services, including controlling and maintaining the City's finances, property, functions, services, affairs, and programs in accordance with the City Charter adopted by the citizens of Lago Vista.

In addition to their regular duties, elected members serve as liaisons on the various appointed City boards and committees. Council members also serve as representatives or liaisons to a number of area, regional, and state organizations.

The City of Lago Vista holds a General Election each November for the purpose of electing City Council Members, jointly with Travis County.
