City of Lago Vista Welcomes New Director of Public Works, Taylor Whichard

Taylor Whichard graduated with a B.S. in Petroleum Engineering from Texas Tech. Prior to working in Municipal Government, Mr. Whichard worked as a Drilling Engineer in the Oil & Gas Industry with a focus on improving operational efficiency and safety.

As the City Engineer for the City of Aberdeen, Maryland, Mr. Whichard was responsible for the review, approval, inspection and acceptance of all residential and commercial development within the City. While in this role, he also worked as the Program Manager on a major military installation. As Program Manager, Mr. Whichard was responsible for the operations and maintenance of the water and sewer infrastructure as well as overseeing the construction of a new water treatment plant.



Prior to Lago Vista, Mr. Whichard most recently worked as the Director of Public Works for the City of Willis, TX. In this role, he was responsible for water distribution, wastewater collection, water and wastewater treatment plants, City parks, and utility billing. In this role he was pivotal in negotiating with developers that were building master planned communities within Willis. During his time in the City of Willis, Mr. Whichard also served on the SJRA – GRP (Groundwater Reduction Plan) Review Committee as the Small City Representative.

Mr. Whichard takes great pride in being honest, transparent and accessible to the people of every city he has worked in. He looks forward to bringing the private industry mentality of hard work and efficiency to the Public Works Department to better serve the great people of Lago Vista.

"There's an App for That" - My Water Advisor 2.0

The City of Lago Vista's new water meters have a helpful feature whereby customers can review and keep track of their water usage on their computer or smartphone using the **My Water Advisor 2.0** portal and mobile app (available for both iOS and Android.)

Before any features of **My Water Advisor 2.0** can be used, customers must first create an account and **REGISTER VIA THE WEB PORTAL** at <https://mywateradvisor2.com/register>.

Once the registration has been completed, you can use the online computer portal for:

- Consumption details
- Leak and budget alerts
- View/Download/Print hourly and daily consumption charts and/or tables
- Compare previous years consumption

On the **mobile app**, key features include **SMS text and email notification of consumption details and leak and/or budget alerts**.
