Asbestos, business waste, chemicals (fuels, oils, refrigerant, etc.), commercial waste, compressed gasses, tires, televisions, industrial waste, items with fluids still inside (freon, gas, etc.), dock floats, construction materials or debris, paints, sailboats, and electronic waste.

ITEMS WE CAN ACCEPT

Appliances (only with refrigerant removed and tagged by an a/c or refrigeration technician), furniture, plastics, scrap metal, and wood products. The following ARE accepted but must be BAGGED: residential waste, leaves, and grass clippings.

Brush, limbs, and trees will NOT be accepted at this event. You may dispose of these at the Green Center on the first Thursday & Saturday of each month.
