Open to all City of Lago Vista utility customers (water/sewer) with proper credentials:

1. UTILITY BILL or ID and
2. STORM BRUSH PASS AND LIABILITY WAIVER

Each vehicle or trailer carrying debris must be certified to have come from the residence of an eligible City of Lago Vista utility customer and MUST CARRY AND HAND TO SITE STAFF a completed STORM BRUSH PASS AND LIABILITY WAIVER signed by the resident prior to gaining entrance to the site. It is necessary to present and submit a completed form for EACH LOAD - even if it comes from the same residence.

Forms can be picked up outside City Hall or downloaded from the City's website at www.lagovistatexas.org/20210302%20--%20Resident%20Brush%20Liability%20Form.pdf.

THE SITE IS ABLE TO ACCEPT:

- Brush
- Tree branches
- Tree trunks (cut down to a manageable size)
- Palm trees/leaves and bamboo

THE SITE IS NOT ABLE TO ACCEPT:

- Debris that is not related to fallen trees caused by the storm
- Grass or other small organic debris that requires bagging
- Storm-damaged residential household or demolition debris

FEMA Offering Storm Recovery Assistance to Individuals with Property Damage

FEMA is offering assistance to Texas residents who were impacted by our recent winter storm. Their [Individuals and Households Program](#) has several requirements that you will need to be aware of. Residents can only seek reimbursement for repairs not covered by private insurance. Repairs must be related specifically to the February storm and must be deemed necessary by FEMA.

YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FEMA ASSISTANCE

If you sustained damage from snow and ice during the winter storms and have insurance, contact your insurance company first and then FEMA. Your insurance claim information is needed to determine eligibility for federal assistance.

If you are uninsured, the fastest and easiest way to apply for assistance is online at DisasterAssistance.gov. You can apply 24 hours a day, seven days a week, with no waiting or delays.

BEFORE YOU APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE

1. Take photos of your damaged home and belongings.
2. Make a list of damaged/lost items.
3. Save yourself time. If you have insurance, you must file a claim with your insurance company. If you do not have insurance, continue to **HOW TO APPLY**.

HOW TO APPLY

You may apply for the Individuals and Households Program or check your application status at DisasterAssistance.gov. You may also access FEMA via a smartphone by downloading the application from their website or through your mobile provider's application store.

You may call FEMA toll-free at 1-800-621-FEMA (1-800-621-3362) to apply for assistance or check your application status.
