Sunset Park Opens to the Public

The City of Lago Vista is excited to open Sunset Park to the public with the completion of **Phase 1 construction**. Sunset Park is the newest City park located at 21817 FM 1431 across from the Balcones Canyonland National Wildlife Refuge. Sunset Park has a soccer field, a baseball field, a softball field, a sand volleyball court, and a 1.8-mile walking trail.

Phase 2 of Sunset Park is currently in the engineering stage and is set to begin construction this calendar year. This phase will include two additional baseball fields, permanent restrooms, a large playground structure, and additional recreational activities for people of all ages.

Answering some of your regularly asked questions:

- Permanent restrooms should be completed by the end of May. There are three portable restrooms on site now.
- There are no plans at this time for construction of pickleball courts.
- Sunset Park is owned and operated is operated by the City of Lago Vista. No membership or paid entry passes are needed to enjoy the park. Everyone is welcome.
- Lights are included in Phase 3 - date of construction is yet to be determined.
- At this time the sports fields are free to the public and is first come, first served.

Parks and Recreation Director Chris Mobley stated "We are very pleased and excited to be able to open this park to our residents. Sunset Park is a tremendous asset to this City." **The park is open 7 days a week from 7 am - 8 pm.**

Local taxes fund government services including police and fire services, education and health services, libraries, road maintenance, and other programs and projects which benefit the community at large. Many of these services also receive federal funds in the form of grants.

City of Lago Vista's Sales Tax distribution for December 2020 was **\$65,770** - a **27% increase** over December 2019.

Total City Sales Tax distribution for 2020 was **\$746,337** - a **38% increase** over 2019.

Pickup is a great way for customers in Lago Vista to get to important destinations such as shopping, medical services, City Hall, the Library, parks, car repair business, special events and more.

To get started, download the app for iPhone or Android, register your account and book a trip. Customers are also able to hail a ride by calling 512-369-6200. A single ride costs just \$1.25 no matter where you go or how far within the Lago Vista service zone.
