Household Hazardous Waste Now Picked Up at Your Doorstep

Beginning in November, Lago Vista Residents can have Household Hazardous Waste collected directly from your doorstep by a HHW Solutions. The service is provided as part of a flat fee of \$1.13 each month on residential utility bills. Hazardous Waste pickup allows residents to clear out their sheds or garages without having to wait for special events to get rid of these items.

To schedule a pickup, visit www.hhwsolutions.com. On the website, select **SCHEDULE A PICK-UP**, then select **LAGO VISTA**. The next available collection day will be shown at the top of the page. Complete the contact information form and click **SUBMIT**. Or if you would prefer, you may call HHW Solutions at **888.694.4978** or **888.MY-HHW-PU**.

PROPER HANDLING

- * Chemicals must be in their original labeled containers, except used motor oil and cooking oil.
- * All items must have spill-proof lids
- * Collect oil in a container with a screw-top lid.
- * All Items must have easily read labels
- * For small sized containers, items must fit into a box no larger than 20" x 14" x 14" in size.
- * Please note that items set out without scheduling, will NOT be collected.

ITEMS ACCEPTED

- * Used motor oil and used cooking oil (screw top lid)
- * Batteries of all kinds
- * Paint of all kinds
- * Light bulbs of all kinds
- * Household cleaners
- * Aerosol cans
- * Automotive fluids and fuels
- * Lawn and garden items including fertilizer, pesticides and weed killers
- * Pool chemicals and additives
- * Varnishes, strippers, turpentine and stains
- * Glues and epoxies

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- * Asbestos / arsenic / cyanide
- * Business / commercial waste
- * Chemicals not in original containers
- * Explosives
- * Medical waste / infectious waste / sharps
- * Nuclear/radioactive waste
- * Pharmaceuticals
- * Propane and butane cylinders
- * Radioactive materials
- * Tires and trash
- * Unidentified chemicals

The History and Meaning of Veterans Day

Thursday, November 11
(City Hall will be closed in observance.)

In November 1919, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed November 11 as the first commemoration of Armistice Day (aka Veterans Day) with the following words: "To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those who died in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory, both because of the thing from which it has freed us and because of the opportunity it has given America to show her sympathy with peace and justice in the councils of the nations..."

Veterans Day continues to be observed on November 11, regardless of what day of the week it falls on. This is a day to honor America's veterans for their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the common good.
