Now is a great time to get a jump on your clean-up projects before the winter months arrive. Clean Up Days provides all Lago Vista utility customers with the opportunity to get rid of large trash items for free. This is a self-serve drop-off event. You drop it, we take it away. Please be sure to read all rules.

LOCATION: Behind the Lago Vista Police Department at 5901 Municipal Complex Way, Lago Vista, TX 78645

ACCEPTED ITEMS: Grass clippings and leaves (**MUST BE BAGGED**), appliances (**refrigerant MUST be removed and tagged by an HVAC or refrigeration technician**), electronic waste (computers, laptops, printers, tablets, etc.), furniture, plastics, scrap metal, and wood products.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT: Normal household waste, industrial waste, chemical products, oil filters, herbicides & pesticides, radioactive material, solvents, paint (except completely dried latex paint cans, no liquids), other flammable liquids, aerosol cans, propane tanks, motor oil, transmission oil, lubricating/hydraulic oil, oil filters, contaminated oil (mixed with solvents, gasoline, etc.), antifreeze, petroleum-contaminated soil, lead paint chips, tires, computers, monitors, televisions, microwaves, fluorescent tubes, medical waste, asbestos, animals, all liquids, flammable, thinners, lacquers, batteries, infectious waste, contaminated soils, fuels, car batteries, adhesives or industrial drums, any material made of or believed to contain radioactive, volatile, corrosive, highly flammable, explosive, biomedical, infectious, biohazardous, toxic, or any other hazardous material as defined by applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations. **NOTE: ABSOLUTELY NO COMMERCIAL OR CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS OR MATERIALS.**

Grass clippings and leaves that aren't bagged WILL NOT be accepted. To dispose of these materials, bring them to the Green Center on regularly scheduled days - first Thursday of each month from 7 a.m. - 4 p.m. and first Saturday of each month from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. at the Green Center location at 21155 FM 1431 (1/4 mile west of Lago Vista Middle School.) ***This is not the location of Clean Up Days.**

PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY ITEMS TO THE CLEAN UP DAYS SITE PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

PLEASE BE CERTAIN TO PROPERLY SECURE LOADS FOR SAFETY ON THE ROADS.

On September 16, 2021, Mayor Ed Tidwell signed a proclamation naming October as Hill Country Night Sky Month. In honor of the proclamation, Lago Vista Starry Skies group will hold a Star Party at Sunset Park on October 9 from 6:30 - 9 p.m. to introduce our citizens to the night sky. Astronomers Alvin Huey, Tom Campbell, Gary Robertson, and James Negri will be there with their telescopes and answers for many questions. Information will be presented about how to stay Dark Sky compliant by shielding exterior light bulbs and only using light when necessary. Bring the kids for facepainting and the chance to learn about the constellations. Starry Skies will also be at the Farmer's Market near City Hall on October 17 with educational information and to answer questions.
