The 2020 Census is Important for Lago Vista *So Why are We Lagging Behind in Response Rates?*

Lago Vista is currently running far behind in the 2020 Census Response Rate compared to that of national, state, county, and neighboring cities. Low response rates for the 2020 Census can spell trouble for us. Let's look quickly at some basic information - what is the Census, why is it important for us, is our information private, and how do we respond?

ONLY 25.4% OF LAGO VISTA RESIDENTS HAVE RESPONDED.

Dr. Lila Valencia, a senior demographer in the Texas Demographic Center, explains that for every Travis County resident who is not counted, the county loses at least \$1,500 per year.

The census happens every 10 years, and this is the first year you can **fill it out online at 2020Census.gov** or over the phone. In the United States, the census is officially a big deal. Originally, the census was meant to be a way to count everyone so that the members of the House of Representatives could be allocated properly to the states. **Today the federal government allocates billions of dollars to states for all sorts of programs, much of it based on population. The census provides the only official head count. EVERYONE IS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW TO RESPOND.**

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT The Federal Government disperses **\$6.75 billion** annually among states based on population. With a 1% undercount in the 2010 census, **Texas lost \$3.59 billion in federal funding during a 10-year period**, according to Census Bureau data. **Travis County is estimated to have lost well over \$1 million.** Every City in Travis County is relied upon to correct this trend in our county, including Lago Vista.

HOW DOES THIS AFFECT LAGO VISTA? **Funding on the local level is also based on population.** This is funding for our schools, emergency services, disaster relief, roads, infrastructure, education, and more. **Undercounting our population is like leaving money on the table. If only 25% of Lago Vistans respond to the census, then the City would theoretically lose funding for the 75% of us who don't.**

PRIVACY AND SECURITY OF CENSUS DATA By law, the **CENSUS BUREAU CAN-NOT SHARE CENSUS ANSWERS WITH OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES**, including welfare agencies, immigration, the police or FBI, the Internal Revenue Service, courts or the military. Under the provisions of Title 13 of the U.S. Code, **census workers who break this law face up to five years in prison or \$250,000 in fines or both** [source: U.S. Census Bureau]. The law works — millions of questionnaires are processed without any breach of trust.
