Keep Lago Vista Beautiful's #LagoLitterChallenge

Maintaining a clean and tidy community requires all of us to pitch in. There are many
ways to do this. One easy way is keeping recycled rubbish off the street and in the bins
where it belongs.

**Approximately 435 million pieces of visible litter
accumulate on Texas roadways each year.**

One of the most common pieces of litter is paper products. A considerable amount of
paper litter in Lago Vista comes from items falling out of recycling bins. Our recycle
material is not bagged like our trash, so when the carts are picked up loose, lightweight
pieces can fall out and be carried by the wind to litter our streets. Overfilling recycle carts
is a common cause of spills. Make sure cart lids are firmly closed.

Other ways to control spillage is to avoid putting separate small pieces of paper into the
cart. Put small pieces of paper in recycled envelopes. Break down cardboard boxes. Put
shredded paper in paper bags. Finally, check the area and pick up any spilled items. If we
all accept the Lago Litter Challenge we can reduce unsightly litter and Keep Lago Vista
Beautiful. **Tag your litter pickup efforts at #LagoLitter Challenge.**

November at the Library

Despite the rise and fall in COVID-19 cases throughout the state, the library has been
able to remain open with limited hours. Under our Grab & Go policy, we ask anyone who
is sick or running a fever to please stay home! Everyone is required to wear a mask while
inside the building, and hand sanitizer is available in several locations throughout the
library. **We're open Monday through Friday, from 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.**

We continue to take precautions to ensure the safety of staff, volunteers, and visitors. All
returned books and other library materials are quarantined for at least 72 hours before
being reshelfed or checked out to other patrons. Three distantly spaced public computers
may be used for essential needs only. Staff will be happy to copy, fax, or scan documents
for patrons. No group meetings are being held inside the library at this time; however,
several of our ongoing book clubs and other groups continue to hold virtual meetings.
Curbside delivery of books, printed documents, or other materials is available upon re-
quest.

The Friends of the Lago Vista Public Library (FOL), a 501(c)(3) organization that raises
funds to support the library, has been unable to hold any book sales or its popular
Membership Fundraiser Dinner this year. Anyone can become an FOL member or renew
their membership either by mail or by stopping by the library. The various membership
levels are available on the library's website. Also, there are several shelves of FOL books
for sale year-round inside the library. FOL funds have been used to purchase books, furni-
ture, computers, software, equipment, and other items for the library.
