

Lago Vista to Hold the 29th Annual La Primavera Bicycle Race the Weekend of February 29 - March 1, 2020



The North Lake Travis Chamber of Commerce in conjunction with the Texas Bicycle Racing Association (TXBRA) will be hosting the 29th Annual La Primavera Lago Vista Bicycle Race on **Saturday, February 29th and Sunday, March 1st, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. each day**. An estimated 600 cyclists from around the world are expected to participate in this sanctioned Texas Cup Peloton Race event through the hills of Lago Vista.

Race Director, Don Hutchison, describes La Primavera as Texas' favorite bike race. Serious cyclists take part in the race for its challenging hills and scenic views along Highland Lake Drive and Boggy Ford Road.

Highland Lake and Boggy Ford will remain open with over 80 volunteers who will direct traffic at the major intersections.

Drivers are strongly advised to reduce their speeds significantly and watch for cyclists, pedestrians, equipment, and other vehicles sharing the roadways.

The event is free for spectators. Bring lawn chairs to settle in to watch these impressive athletes. A food vendor will be on hand all day Saturday and Sunday. Parking is available in areas surrounding the starting line near Santa Rosa Avenue and Highland Lakes Drive.

The City of Lago Vista's \$500,000 grant from Texas Parks and Wildlife to complete Phase 1 of a 3-phase project is scheduled to be completed by late spring or early summer of 2020.
