A lower energy bill can be a valuable New Year's goal. Take Care of Texas offers the following tips to help you not only reduce lighting and heating costs, but also give you that warm feeling knowing you're doing something good for the environment.

Turn down your thermostat. When you're asleep or out of the house, turn your thermostat back 10 to 15 degrees for eight hours and save around 10 percent on your heating bills.

Use the sun's heat. Open curtains on south-facing windows during the day allowing sunlight to heat your home. Close them at night to reduce the chill you may feel from cold windows.

Change your HVAC filter regularly, especially during the heavy-use winter months. A dirty filter slows airflow, making the system work harder, which wastes energy. Replace it at least every three months.

Limit using your wood-burning fireplace. It provides ambiance, but it's inefficient. Fireplace drafts can pull warm air up the chimney, robbing warmth from other rooms. Be sure to keep the damper closed unless a fire is burning.

Weatherize your home. Caulk around windows, doors, and pipes to seal air gaps and add weather stripping to doors and windows. This can save you up to 10 percent on your heating bills. Also, check to make sure your attic is insulated properly. Most homes do not have enough insulation.

Start the New Year with Programs at the Library

The Lago Vista Public Library has received a \$10,309 grant from the Ladd and Katherine Hancher Library Foundation to purchase three Early Literacy Workstations from AWE Learning, a Pennsylvania based company whose mission is to "inspire an enthusiasm for learning by supporting school readiness and literacy in the community."

Designed to attract and educate toddlers through early elementary school ages, the self-contained computer/workstations do not require the internet; thus providing a safe learning environment. The workstations offer some 70 programs with more than 4,000 localized learning activities. Children have access to multi-curricular content - math, science & nature, social studies & geography, reading, art & music, writing & computer skills, and reference.
