Lago Vista Golf Course Undergoing Improvement Projects



Greens Renovation: [LVGC](#) will be rebuilding the greens on holes 5, 6, and 7. This process includes the complete rebuild of all three greens including new drainage material and putting surface. The construction phase will take approximately three weeks. This phase includes the removal of all old material from approximately 16 inches underground up to the putting surface and rebuilding with all new material. The grow-in phase will take approximately eight weeks which is the time it takes for the new grass to fill in the putting surface. We expect these greens to be reopened for play sometime in mid-August. In the meantime, we will have temporary greens set up on these three holes until the new putting surfaces are ready for play.

Restroom Renovation: [LVGC](#) will be doing a complete remodel of the current restrooms on the golf course. Renovation work includes new paint, flooring, sinks and mirrors, toilets, and light fixtures. The process for the remodel will be to complete one of the two existing restrooms at each location first and then move on to the next location. This ensures that a single restroom will always be available for use during the renovation process. The approximate time for completion of the restrooms is four weeks.

We would like to thank you in advance for your patience and understanding during our remodel. We can't wait to show off our improved facility after construction is complete!

CITY OF LAGO VISTA'S TEMPORARY DISINFECTANT CONVERSION FROM CHLORAMINE TO FREE CHLORINE JUNE 1- 28, 2020

The City of Lago Vista public water system, (PWS) ID 2270092, will temporarily convert the disinfectant used in the distribution system from chloramine to free chlorine. The conversion will begin on June 1st and continue through June 28th. During this period, you may experience taste and odor changes associated with this type of temporary disinfectant conversion.

Public water systems are required to properly disinfect their water and maintain an adequate disinfectant residual in the distribution system. Chloramine, free chlorine combined with ammonia, is widely used as a disinfectant because it persists for long periods while also limiting the formation of disinfection by-product contaminants. Prolonged use of chloramine coupled with other factors that can impact water quality, such as high temperatures or stagnation of water, may result in the growth and/or persistence of organic matter within the pipes of the distribution system, which may hinder the ability to maintain an adequate disinfectant residual. A temporary conversion to free chlorine, partnered with flushing activities, helps to rid distribution pipes of this organic matter and improve the quality of your water overall.

The City of Lago Vista has chosen to implement a temporary disinfectant conversion to free chlorine based on the following: Annual Free chlorine Burn (Preventive Maintenance)
