

How Your Winter Water Use Affects Your Sewer Rate



Your actual water usage during the months of November 2020, January 2021, and February 2021 is averaged to determine your sewer rates for your monthly bill. This is known as winter averaging rates.

These months are deliberately chosen because they tend to have the lowest consumption for most customers. The end result is that those who are conservative in their usage will pay less for sewer services. Those who use more water and place a greater burden on the treatment facilities will pay more.

New winter averaging rates will be calculated in April of 2021 and due on your bills beginning in May 2021.



North Lake Travis Chamber of Commerce's event



City crews will be working on a Valve Inspection & Maintenance project in the Southwest area of town and will continue to work towards the North and East sides of town for the remainder of this year. All too often, older valves do not properly function when the City has to repair a broken pipe. That can lead to a much larger water outage. Performing regular maintenance and identifying these broken or inoperable valves helps curb total water loss and lowers the amount of time it takes to restore service.

During the project there will be short intermittent water interruptions as crews exercise and test the main pipeline valves. The City does not anticipate the outages to last more than 30 minutes at any one time

on each pipe or street. Please monitor the City's Facebook page and website to note the dates of work and specific areas of town affected by the project.

As a result of water service interruptions, residents in the immediate vicinity of the work may experience a temporary discoloration of their water once service is restored. This discoloration is caused by air in the water mains and does not affect the safety of the water. If you experience this, clear air and deposits in the water pipes by running your water faucets for a minute or two.

City's New Park is Named - Lago Vista Sunset Park

Lago Vista residents took part in an online poll to vote for their favorite choice of proposed names for the new City park located at 21817 FM 1431. The winner, receiving the most votes and announced at the October 15 City Council Meeting, is Lago Vista Sunset Park. Sunset Park is derived from the name of the piece of land the City purchased - Sunset Ranch. The 30-acre park will host ball fields, sand volleyball, a soccer field, scent garden, special events, and more. Construction of Phase 1 is underway.
