FYI The Lago Vista City Council voted to reinstate charging all credit and debit card payments, a processing fee to help cover the City's cost for accepting credit and debit card payments. Effective December 1, 2023, a 3% fee will apply across the board to all departments: Golf Course, Court, Utilities, Police Department, Development Services, My Permits Now permitting system, and the Airport fuel farm.
