I am pleased to present a comprehensive overview of our team's accomplishments throughout the month of November.



I want to draw attention to our Code Enforcement statistics. As you are aware, both Code Enforcement / Animal Control positions are currently vacant. Notably, due to delayed access to the Code Enforcement case tracking software until the final week of November, our statistics were manually compiled. With the recent implementation of the software and our ongoing efforts to fill vacant positions, we anticipate improved accuracy in tracking moving forward as our staff becomes more familiar with the system.

In our commitment to reinforcing our workforce, extensive interviews were conducted for vacancies in Patrol, Dispatch, and Code Enforcement. I am pleased to announce that several job offers have been extended and accepted. We anticipate these new team members to commence their roles with us in December.

In conclusion, November marked a highly successful month for our team, setting a positive tone as we approach the year's final month. Your continued support is invaluable, and I remain at your disposal for any inquiries pertaining to this report or our department's activities.

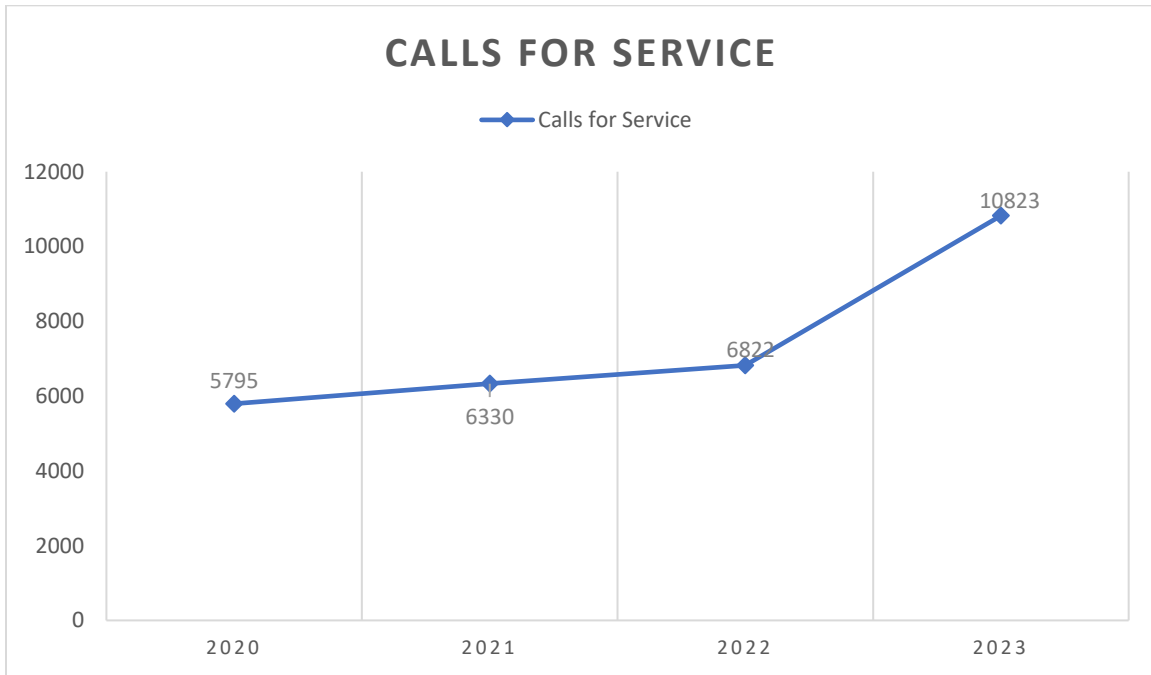

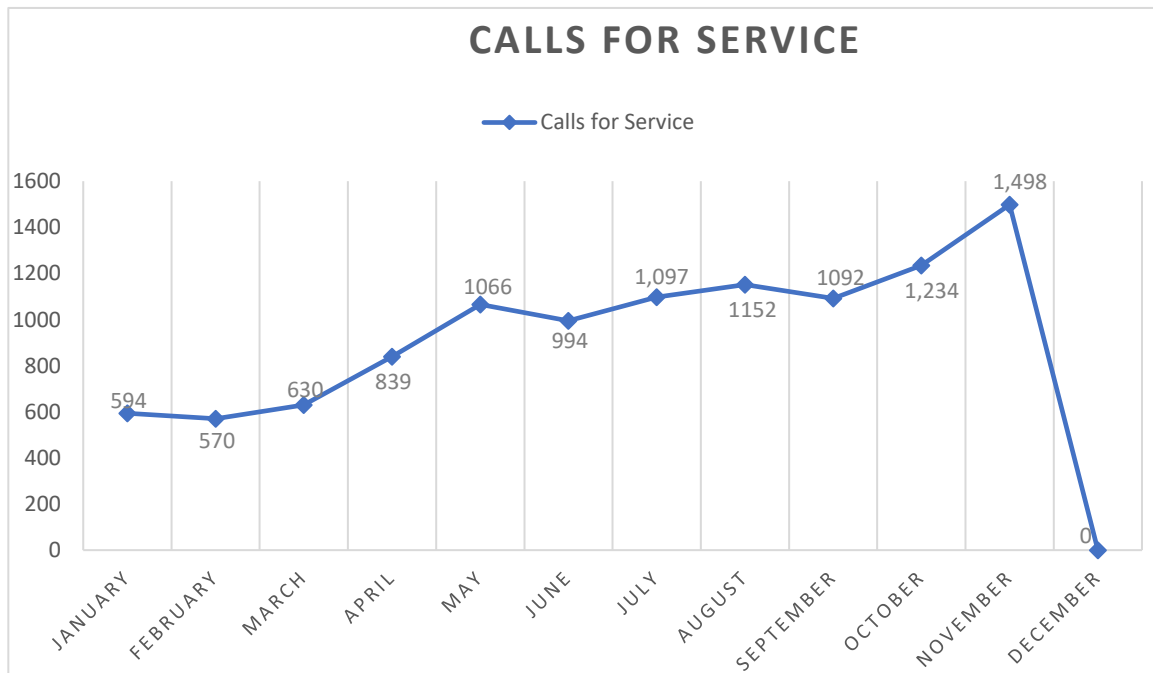

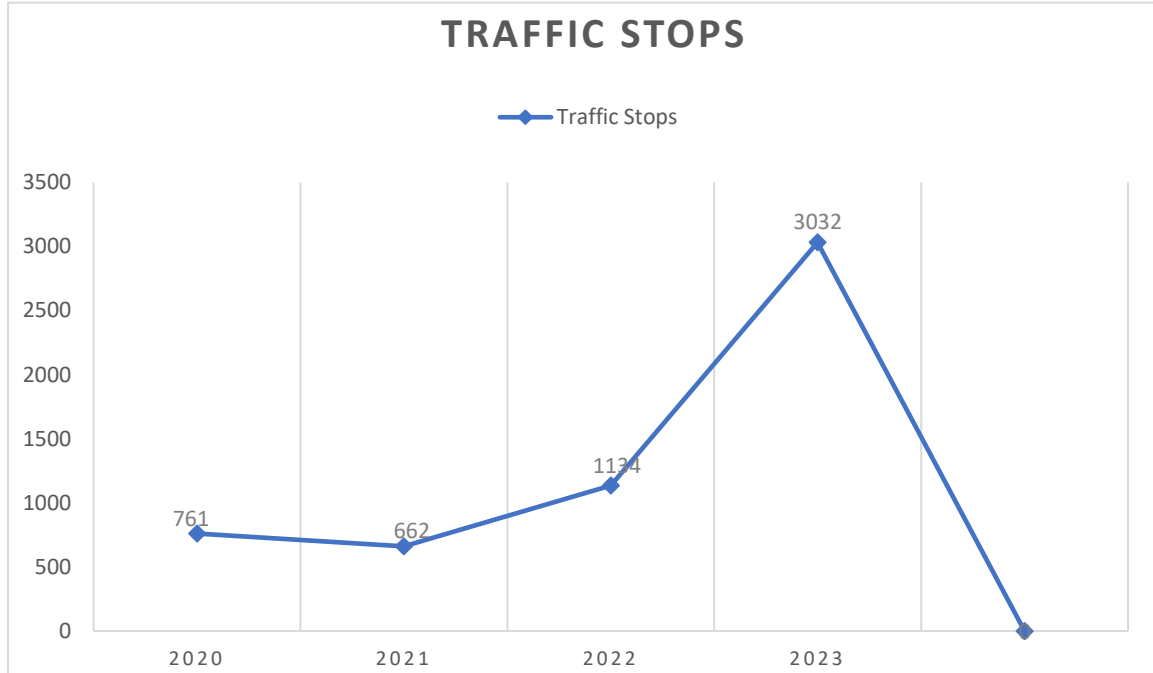
Calls for Service – Historical and Year-to-Date



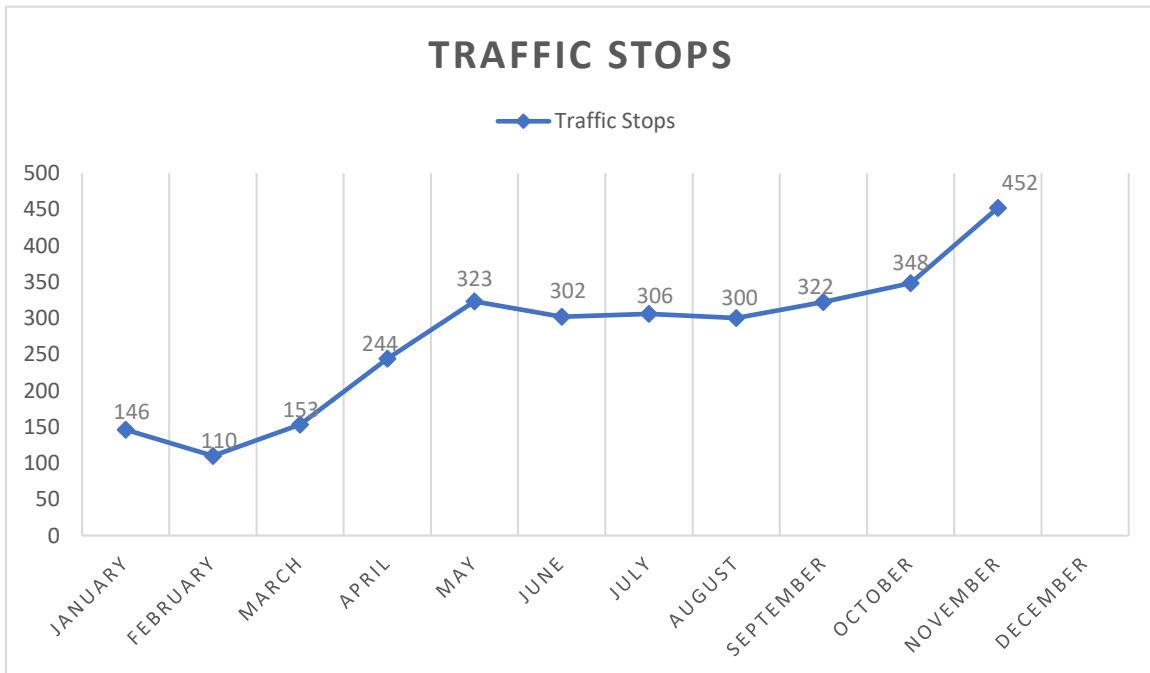
Calls for Service – 2023 by Month

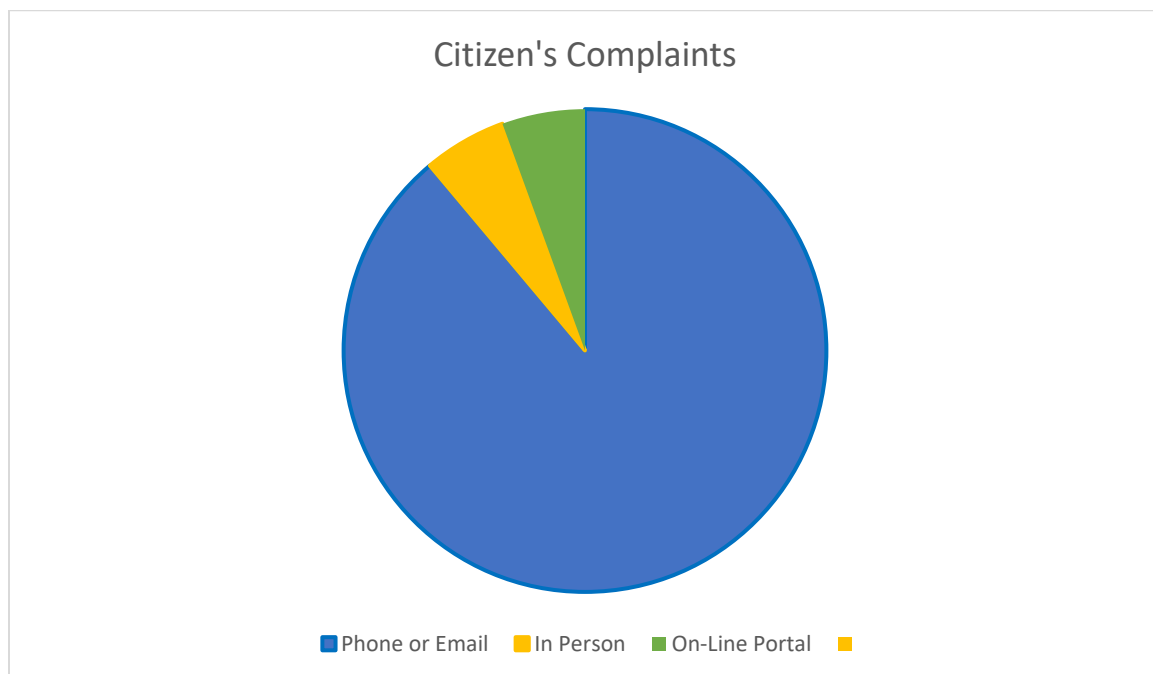
Summary
