New Annual Sewer Rate takes affect on May Utility Bill!

Your actual water usage during the months of November 2023 - February 2024 are reviewed to determine your sewer rate for your monthly bill. The lowest two months of metered water usage of those four are then averaged to determine your new sewer rate. These months are deliberately chosen because they tend to have the lowest consumption for most customers. The end result is that those who are conservative in their usage will pay less for sewer services. Those who use more water and place a greater burden on the treatment facilities will pay more. New winter averaging rates were calculated in April of 2024 and due on your bills beginning in May 2024.
