**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS
APPOINTING AN INDIVIDUAL TO SERVE AS COUNCIL LIAISON TO THE PARKS AND
RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE 2024 TERM.**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 7.8 of the City's Rules of Procedure, the Council may appoint individual Council Members to serve as a liaison to City boards, committees, and commissions, as well as county-wide, regional and local community organizations; and

WHEREAS, Council liaisons serve an important role to be a resource to support the committee, commission or board and to be a voice of for the Council to community organizations; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with paragraph 7.8(6)(a), after elections each November, city council members will discuss each committee, current liaison assignments, proposed changes, and make liaison assignments for the upcoming year; and

WHEREAS, City Council appointed Councilor Stephanie Smith to serve as the liaison to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee on December 7, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Councilor Smith has identified a need to step down from serving as liaison effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it prudent to assign a new member to serve as liaison to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee to fulfill the duties and responsibilities in accordance with the City's Rules of Procedure for the remainder of 2024 term.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
