

RESOLUTION NO. 24-2080

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR EFFORTS TO PROCURE FEDERAL FUNDING FOR THE EXPANSION OF WASTEWATER AND DRINKING WATER INFRASTRUCTURE THROUGH COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING DOLLARS WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF CONGRESSMAN MICHAEL MCCAUL'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the City of Lago Vista, Texas has experienced significant population growth in recent years, driven in part by the pro-growth policies of neighboring urban centers such as Austin; and

WHEREAS, the City's water and wastewater infrastructure is critical to ensuring the continued health, safety, and economic well-being of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the importance of responsibly managing its debt levels and avoiding the fiscal challenges that have burdened other communities that have maximized their bond debt; and

WHEREAS, access to safe drinking water and reliable wastewater services is essential in the State of Texas, particularly in rapidly growing communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lago Vista is actively pursuing federal funding through community project funding dollars to support the expansion of its wastewater and drinking water infrastructure, and is working with Congressman Michael McCaul's office to secure such funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lago Vista is committed to collaborating with local elected officials, community organizations, and other stakeholders to ensure the success of these efforts and to seek additional local support;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS:

1. That the City of Lago Vista hereby expresses its full support for efforts to procure federal funding for the expansion of the City's wastewater and drinking water infrastructure through community project funding dollars, with the assistance of Congressman Michael McCaul's office.

2. That the City of Lago Vista encourages the involvement and support of local elected officials, organizations, and community members in this effort to ensure the future growth and sustainability of the City's infrastructure.

3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, and Councilor Shane R. Saum is permitted to communicate the City's support for this effort to Congressman McCaul's office, as well as to other relevant local, state, and federal agencies.
