### New Annual Sewer Rate takes affect on May Utility Bill!

Your water usage from November 2024 to February 2025 will be reviewed to determine your sewer rate for the upcoming months. The two months with the lowest water usage during this period are averaged to calculate your new sewer rate. These months are specifically selected because they typically reflect the lowest consumption for most customers. As a result, customers who use less water will pay a lower sewer fee, while those who consume more water and place greater demand on treatment facilities will incur a higher fee.

New winter averaging rates, determined in April 2025, will be reflected in your bills starting in May 2025.

If you have any questions about how your winter averaging rate is calculated, please contact our utility line at City Hall at 512-267-1155, Monday through Thursday, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
